

Inter Cricket Rules

- Each team has one innings
- An innings is closed after 10 over's or after all batters are out
- Batters change ends after the end of each over
- Bowl from one end only
- The ball which follows a no-ball or wide is a free hit (striker cannot out on that hit)
- Batters may run on any ball whether it is hit or not. Batters score runs by running between the strikers popping crease and the “running crease” (score one for each completed run).
- All players must bowl one over before any one player can commence a second over.

Dismissal

- Batters may be caught out
- To run out a batter running to the “running crease” the wicket must be broken at the end the batter is running towards
- LBW may only be given if a batter deliberately blocks the ball with their leg to prevent it hitting the wicket
- A single remaining batter may continue batting, changing ends as necessary to receive strike
- A partner must run with the remaining batter; the whole side is out when the solo batter is out or either player is run out.

Scoring

- Batting bonus if a team scores 75+ runs , they get 1 point added bonus
- 100+ runs means 2 points added bonus points
- 125+ runs means 3 points added bonus points
- Except for the wicket keeper, no fielder is allowed to stand within 10 yards of the striking batter until the ball is played
- Add two runs to the team score for each no-ball or wide ball bowled by the opposing team
- 1 run scored for hitting the wall plus any score already run. (if indoors)
