

Simplified Basketball Rules

1. Start the game with a jump ball.
2. If a player commits a personal foul on the court the fouled team take a sideline ball inline and to the nearest side where the offense took place, they have 5 seconds to make the pass.
3. If a player commits a personal foul to the someone as they are attempting a 3 point shot they get a free throw. If they shooter scores even though fouled, they could therefore win 4 points (3 from the three point shot and 1 for the free throw).
4. If a defender knocks the ball off the sideline or backline, a sideline ball is awarded to the attackers in line with where it went off.
5. When a basket is scored the conceding, team restarts the game with a backline ball from their defensive backline.
6. If a player commits a travel offense a sideline ball is taken from the nearest sideline in line with where the offense took place.
7. If a player scores outside the 3 point line they score 3 points, if they score within the 3 point line they score 2 points.
